## Our Work

- Pray for the continued political turmoil in Haiti. The current CPT leading the country, their mandate is set to expire February 7th. There is no firm plan for elections as of yet, neither has the country's security situation improved. Continue to pray for clear, decisive leadership moving forward. Haiti has lacked that for some years now, which has contributed to the current situation.
- Pray for HNP (Haitian National Police) as they have been much more active since the beginning of the new year in combatting the gangs.
- Pray for several of our Haitian staff members who are able to take courses online from an organization called Medicines for Humanity. Our staff are taking courses in health administration, leadership, project management, and nutrition. Please pray our staff can gain knowledge and strengthen our effectiveness through this opportunity to learn remotely.

- Pray for the RHFH board as we enter into a new year. We are blessed to have an additional board member, Kristin Vanderwell, join our team to help us in our mission. She joins 7 others currently serving on our board of directors. Pray God grant them wisdom and discernment as we evaluate our programs and fine tune our strategic plan.



- Pray for our staff members required to travel outside of Cazale to transport patients and bring back supplies. Four of our staff were stranded for two nights between gang controlled areas due to fighting, but ultimately they were able to return to Cazale safely. It was a sobering reminder to the perils of traveling in the current instability. We would continue to ask you to pray for traveling mercies.

- Pray for Abigail, who was recently married, that God would bless her and her new husband.
- Pray for Briana as she continues her treatment and recovery from tuberculosis.
- Pray for Grace Zachary as she travels to California to visit two colleges in February. Pray God would give her discernment as she moves towards her next step in her education.
- Pray for Lori as she is the only staff missionary currently in Cazale. She has a lot of responsibility on her shoulders. Pray God would strengthen and sustain her. Pray for deep rest and energy to persevere through this season.
