


# Real Hope For Haiti

During the fourth quarter, we provided care for a total of 73 patients, including 23 new admissions, 4 deaths, and 21 successful discharges. During this time, the children were served 790 pieces of chicken and 1,036 cups of rice. We also used 254 pounds of laundry soap and provided 1,398 gallons of drinking water. In addition to daily care, the staff focused on activities for older children, including learning to read and write and story time, which has become an important part of their routine.

*Clinic*

A total of 6304 patients were given care, including 2,120 children under 14 years old. Birthing supplies were provided for 74 babies born this quarter. Wound care nurses changed 2967 dressings, cared for 72 emergencies, and sutured 74 lacerations. There were 4271 lab tests done for 1193 patients. Health topics for group education focused on paying off debts, planting kitchen gardens for nutrition, and having a good relationship with God.



*Community  
Group*

In 2025, our community group completed: an outhouse, a caretaker room, fencing, gate, tree nursery, and a large rock retaining wall to manage rain runoff. In quarter four, we planted 530 vetiver plants and placed 190 dirt bags as retaining walls in ravines to fight erosion. We worked 9 days, met 6 times, and remain 13 members strong.
