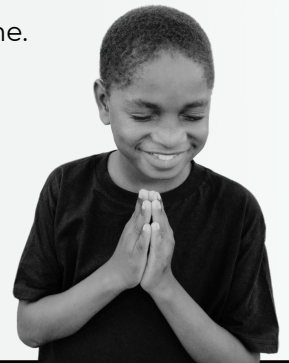


PRAYERS UP!

- Pray for O.M. who is suffering from chronic back pain that is debilitating. She desires prayer for a touch from God to heal her and restore her quality of life.
- Pray for F.P. who is discouraged because she works and works and does not feel like she is progressing in life or advancing in any way. She wants prayer that God would open doors for her or give her creative ideas on how to sustain her life economically.
- Pray for M.A. who is a child that came to clinic dehydrated and required oxygen. His parents ask for prayer that God would touch their child and restore his health.
- Pray for D.J. who is a young woman who is very discouraged. Her husband died. Both of her parents died as well. She needs prayer that God might give her strength and help heal her heartache.
- Pray for A.S. that has an abscess in her neck. She has been to several clinics and had several exams with no resolution. Pray our staff can coordinate her care and find a solution for her, by the grace of God.
- Pray for E.N. who is suffering from a high fever and body aches. Pray God will use the medicines we provided and His strong hand to relieve the pain and discomfort and make him healthy and whole again.



Our Work

- We have seen an uptick in conversions and re-dedications to Christ at clinic lately. Pray for the chaplains as they proclaim the truth of God's Word. Pray for open hearts. Pray for the power of the Gospel to continue to transform lives. We had given out all our Bibles. (A good problem for a missionary to have!) Thank you to those who give towards the purchasing of Bibles. We purchased two more cases of Bibles in February to continue to bless those coming to Christ.
- Pray for a biblical formation class our chaplains are conducting in the afternoons for children in our community. We paused these classes for a couple years because of the security situation, but due to demand and willingness of our staff, we have restarted this aspect of the ministry. Pray for good fruit to come of it!
- Continue to pray for Haiti. The next month is critical in the preparation of forces from various countries to arrive in Haiti in April that will constitute a Gang Suppression Force.

- After years and years of bad reports, February has some positive things happening in Haiti. There was a peaceful transition of power from the governing council of the CPT to the current Prime Minister Alix Didier Fils-Aime. There was concern that some members of the CPT were going to try to hold onto power leading up to the February 7th date, but international pressure prevented political shenanigans from happening. Please pray for PM Fils-Aime, that he would have clear and decisive leadership to move the country forward. A key location in PAP, what is called Karfu Aeroport, in the heart of PAP was secured and activities returned to it after some years under gang control. The Gang Suppression Force indicated one of their primary efforts in stabilizing security will be to regain control of roads leading in and out of PAP, which would greatly help our efforts at RHFH. Pray for their success.



- Continue to pray for our board of directors as we pray, think, and talk through RHFH's strategic plan.
- Pray for those students pursuing various degrees that RHFH is putting through school, from nurses, to doctors, to physical therapists to social workers. We are thrilled to be investing in the future of healthcare workers in Haiti, and we are thankful to a generous hospital in MN that makes it possible.

- Pray safety for Casey as he will be traveling to Haiti March 20-April 10th.
- Pray Lori will AT LEAST take a nap while Casey is visiting. Seriously though, pray for God to continue to strengthen and equip Lori with every good gift she needs to do all God has called her to do for such a time as this. It is not ideal with Licia and Briana and Casey currently living in the USA with their families. Lori continues to be a rock for RHFH, so continue to lift her up to our great God in prayer.
- Thank you for your prayers for Briana as she has been going through treatment for tuberculosis. After some months of problems with medicines negatively impacting her liver function, switching medicines to avoid that, and dealing with constant nausea, God has been good enough to sort the medicines out where she is currently feeling little to no nausea. She appreciates the prayers you have offered up on her behalf and is thankful God heard and answered them.
