- Pray for L.B.B. who is swollen all over his body with kidney, lung, and heart issues and need a miraculous touch from God.

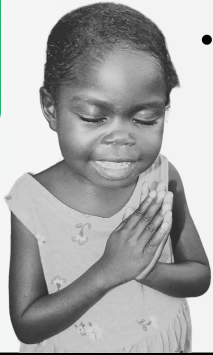


Our Work

While there are still immense problems in the country and armed men remain in control of Cazale, there have been positive signs that the security situation is shifting some. This positive news (police regaining some territory, fewer gang attacks) is an answer to many prayers and a hopeful sign after years of a worsening situation.
- Continue to pray for the international forces (Gang Suppression Force) that are slated to arrive in Haiti at the beginning of April. These differ from the Kenyan troops that are presently here because their mission is more than a peace-keeping mission. The GSF is tasked primarily with actively securing a humanitarian corridor, which largely means securing the roadways in and out of PAP in each direction. Please pray for their effectiveness when they arrive.

- Pray for our doctors, nurses, and staff as they continue to labor in a very difficult environment. Their attitude and effort make us very proud to have them on our staff. Please pray they stay strong in the Lord and the power of His might.
