PRAYERS UP!

Pray for peace across Haiti and for clear communication among leaders and communities. Pray for the patients who come to the clinic and those in need of surgery, that they receive care and do not lose hope and find strength daily.

CLINIC

We served 6469 patients, including 2,117 children under 14. Birthing supplies, education, and consultations were done for 68 newborns and moms. Nurses did 2,901 dressings changes and managed 167 emergencies. We treated 1003 skin infections and 429 fungal infections. Also 278 diarrhea cases were treated and none were suspected cholera. We identified and referred 22 new HIV+ cases. Group patient education was focused on children's skin infection, STI prevention, and Vitamin A & deworming for children.

RESCUE CENTER

This quarter, our inpatient care facility served a total of 41 patients, providing medical care, nutrition, and support. We welcomed 12 new admissions, and we are grateful that 12 children recovered and were able to return home to their families. To meet the nutritional needs of those in our care, we prepared and served 6,630 meals, including 1,456 cups of rice, 687 pieces of chicken, and 1215 cups of milk. Keeping up with daily care also required 205 bars of soap to maintain cleanliness and hygiene.

OUTREACH

We enrolled 134 people in the mamba program, with 50 graduating. 3,952 meals reached 82 Food Box families monthly. Hope Homes sheltered 26 vulnerable children & 6 individuals received medical home support. Our education aid includes 24 school sponsorships and 6 university trainees (1 doctor, 2 nurses, 1 PT, 2 social workers) committed to joining RHFH. We distributed 246 pieces of Biblical literature, gave 1211 spiritual counsel, and special prayer for 540 people. Surgery and emergency aid was given to five people referred to 2 hospitals.

This quarter, 11 individuals accepted Jesus as their Savior. One family came with little hope after their son, Evens, was expected to die. After months of care, he fully recovered. Seeing God's hand, the father chose for their whole family to follow Christ. They prayed with our chaplains and received Bibles. We rejoice that Evens returns home to a family following God and we ask for prayer as they grow in faith and find a local church.

The GVADK community group finalized their 2026 work plan and began implementation. With a caretaker now living on-site, the nursery is growing with 1,040 reforestation trees and 594 vetiver plants for erosion control planting in Q2 and Q3. We also started 50 fruit trees (annual goal is 300) and 358 pepper plants. Improvements include a shade structure, compost bin, and a new security gate, along with ongoing fence maintenance to protect the nursery.
