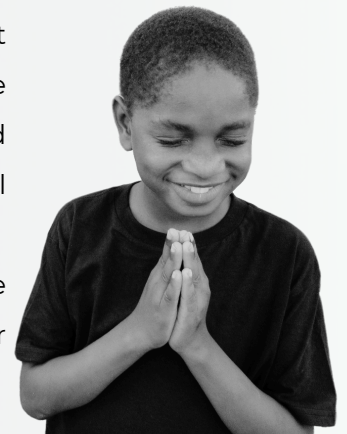


PRAYERS UP!

Patients

- Pray for A.K. who broke his arm recently, requiring surgery to repair. Pray for his continued healing and full recovery.
- Pray for E.G. who had a temperature for 3 days, then his feet and abdomen began to swell. We have yet to determine, so pray we can correctly diagnose and begin treatment to get him on the path to healing and recovery.
- Pray for S.D. who had a very tragic accident involving a propane gas tank while cooking, resulting in burns over the majority of her body. Pray that she would continue to heal her, and God would ease her pain and discomfort as she has already been receiving daily wound care and bandage changes for some time already. She is in severe pain and very discouraged, please pray God's nearness would be a comfort to her.
- Pray for J.E. who is a patient diagnosed with diabetes 10 years ago. She is beginning to have complications, so please pray that increased education and stronger family support can keep further complications at bay. Pray God would grant her a better quality of life.
- Pray for L.C. who recently had a caesarean birth with a healthy baby. Post partum, the mom's entire body began to swell for unexplained reasons, and she is not breastfeeding the baby. Pray our staff can determine what is going on and help treat the patient that would lead to a return to being fully functional enough to care for her newborn baby.
- Pray for G.P. who is a little girl with a hole in her heart needing corrective surgery. Pray God would do a miracle either by healing her or by opening a door for her to receive this surgery where there doesn't seem to be a way at present.

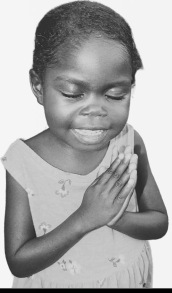


Our Work

- Pray for our chaplains Mathurin, Espenson, and Syllo, as they are working on some quarterly goals this year as a part of our strategic plan. These goals include attempting to assess the needs and begin to reach outside the walls of our clinic and Rescue Center to engage people in Kingdom work. They are traveling once per month to various remote areas in the hills above Cazale to do research and gain information on how we can work to both equip others to evangelize those communities as well as how we can support and strengthen the local churches already serving in those zones.
- Pray for Lori specifically as we are losing a key staff member who is leaving Cazale to go to school in PAP for two years of additional training. This staff member indicates she would like to return to the RHFH team once her education is complete, but it will leave us in a bit of a bind short term until we can find an adequate replacement. Please pray God will provide a capable person to fill this position and strengthen our organization.

Our Work

- Pray for a young girl who has a cleft lip and palate. Foreign surgical teams have not been traveling to Haiti (our general area) for some years due to instability and travel bans, so it is increasingly difficult to find a facility that can do this type of surgery. Pray God would open a door and make a way where there doesn't seem to be a way.
- It is coming into planting season now, so please pray for the hard work going on in and around our community to plant this season. Pray God will provide for sunshine, steady rains and bountiful harvests. Insecurity and fuel shortages have made importing food and transporting it to distribute around the country extremely expensive, so local communities have ramped up local production to attempt to provide for the needs of their citizens



- Please pray for all students that are coming to the end of their school year to remain steadfast in their studies and persevere. Pray they do well in their upcoming exams and pray prayers of praise to God for His grace in getting the students in Cazale through another school year without disruption despite the current context we are in. It is a miracle and a grace from God.
