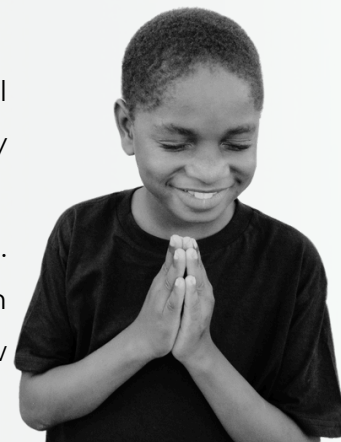


# PRAYERS UP!

## Our Work

- Please pray for those planting gardens and fields all around us during this planting season. Pray God who provides the rains and the sunshine to bring the growth and provide a bountiful crop to sustain the lives of the people and the families in our area. God has been good the past few years. With the insecurity in the country, many in our area have been planting additional crops in every possible place trying to generate more food locally due to transportation complications/ import issues.
- Pray for our chaplains who continue to meet with pastors and church leaders in the mountain villages above us to coordinate evangelism training for the area in 2027. The chaplains are also in the middle of a three month long course with 15 teenagers in Cazale on the Gospel of Matthew. Please pray for their effectiveness in their instruction and for fruit in their student's lives.
- Pray for our nursing, physical therapy, and social work students that are completing their academic year soon. Pray they maintain focus through their final exams and continue to add skills to prepare them for all God has called them to do.

## Our Work

- Pray for continues efforts by the Haitian National Police and the International Gang Suppression Force as they regain territory lost for some years to gang control and secure the routes in and out of PAP. There have been several operations in the past month that have been somewhat effective. Pray the gang members would lay down their weapons and everyone would focus on building a better and brighter future for Haiti.
- Pray for GVADK's efforts to start a tree nursery and restart tree planting efforts in the area to curb erosion and provide for the local community.



- Pray for our staff that continue to labor in very challenging conditions. While we have been blessed to not have significant problems or violence even though Cazale is occupied by the gangs, our staff remains on high alert as the atmosphere is often tense and the gang's actions are unpredictable. This is physically, emotionally, psychologically, and spiritually challenging. Pray they would have confidence in our Father in Heaven, peace rooted in Him, discernment from the Spirit, and joy in Christ, even in the midst of the current dangers.
