- Pray for C.V. who has some mental illness that we are attempting to help her find medication to regulate. She asks for prayer because she trusts God knows everything and can provide a solution or healing for her.
- Pray for J.L.M. who recently had a baby and developed eclampsia and is presently having trouble talking and her family is asking we pray for her to heal and become whole again to care for her new baby.
- Pray for C.O. who is an older woman who has severely swollen feet that causes severe pain and prohibits mobility. Pray our staff can help her improve and heal to regain a better quality of life.
- Pray for J.F. who is suffering from prolonged mental illness. His family asked us to pray for him as he was doing much better on medication for a time, but recently has refused to take his medication and is causing the family much stress. Please pray our staff can continue to help those suffering from mental illness. So many supports and locations they could access help have closed since gang violence exploded in Haiti some years ago. We have seen a sharp increase of patients seeking support since we are still functioning. Please pray for our staff as they are required to travel with these patients to various parts of PAP to find treatment for them. It requires a lot of coordination and risk, so please pray God will continue to open doors for these patients during some very tough times. ## Our Work

- Please continue to pray for our staff and our patients that continue to live in very taxing environments with gangs occupying Cazale and much of the area around us, and virtually all of the area between Cazale and Port au Prince, where we have purchase supplies and transport patients that require a level of care we are not able to provide (surgery).
- Pray for our staffing as some key staff have left recently leaving voids behind in our organization structure and functionality. Some have left to pursue higher education, another left to immigrate to France. Please pray God would bless our staff in these new endeavors. Also pray God would provide us with capable and dedicated staff to replace them that will ensure we will continue to be used of God to provide excellent care.
- Pray for Jordany who was recently placed in a Hope Homes family to be fostered after he fully recovered in our rescue center. Please pray for Jordany and his new family that they would all thrive and God would be glorified in it.
- Pray prayers of thankfulness that we were able to purchase and get new batteries for the CTC to Cazale to replace the ones that were stolen last year.



- Please pray for our supply chain for medika mamba and infant formula. We have been unable to find it in country for some time and our supply is dwindling. Pray these life saving resources we be available again soon to do their good work being used by God to restore health and help children grow!



- Pray for the current class our chaplains are doing on the Gospel of Matthew every Wednesday afternoon with local young people will draw many out of darkness and into the marvelous light of Christ. Pray our chaplains, Mathurin, Syllo, and Espenson would be courageous and clear in expounding on the wonders of God in Christ through Matthew. Thanks to our donors, we were able to replace the tent they were meeting under with a tin shelter just in time for the rainy season. Praise God!

- Please continue to pray for Licia Betor's recovery from recent surgery. The wound is slow to heal and has obligated Licia to take some additional time off of work. Her children are taking tremendous care of her, which is a blessing, and she is improving. Pray God would touch her body and aid her to recuperate entirely.
- Pray for Lori Moise and her husband Charly as they continue to labor in Cazale. Pray God strengthens them to get much done prior to traveling to the US for a board meeting in August, which will be Lori's first break in a year.
