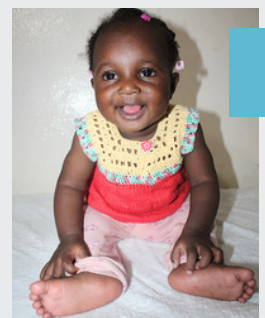
In our laboratory sits a machine that transforms patient care: the Stat-fax analyzer. This equipment performs critical tests that guide our doctors' decisions every day. When a diabetic arrives, we test kidney function before prescribing metformin. When someone comes in swollen, the Stat-fax reveals whether the problem is liver disease or something else. It measures the vital markers that show us exactly what's happening inside our patients' bodies. Without this machine, we would be treating patients blindly. But because of generous donors, we have it. Every test performed is a life guided toward healing. Thank you for making that possible.

Hope child Charlens struggled in school for years, unable to read or write. With donor support, we moved him to a new school and provided after school tutoring. Today, Charlens reads and writes independently. He passed to the next grade with confidence. Thank you for investing in him and his future.



At our clinic, we pour our hearts into every patient. But sometimes, caring deeply means recognizing our limits. When a patient's condition requires specialized care beyond what we can provide, we face a difficult choice. We sit with them honestly, explaining what our tests reveal and why they need a specialist. We listen to their concerns and explore their options together. We prepare an official referral letter, keeping copies for continuity. We don't simply send them away. We walk them toward the care they deserve. This is what patient care truly means: loving them enough to ensure they get exactly what they need.

Five-month-old Danaica from Cazale came to our clinic suffering from fever, flu, and an ear infection. Her mother was worried, but our medical team provided the medication Danaica needed to recover. During her visit, a nurse noticed a beautiful little dress among our donated items. She placed it gently in Danaica's mother's hands. The mother's face lit up with joy seeing her daughter receive this unexpected gift. Thank you to our donors for these loving gestures that bring hope and happiness to families like Danaica's.

Four-year-old Baina from Cazale arrived at our clinic sick with flu and fever. She weighed only 22 pounds and was diagnosed with level 2 malnutrition. Her worried mother knew her daughter needed help. Our medical team provided treatment and enrolled Baina in the Medika Mamba nutrition program. Every day, Baina consumed her Medika Mamba sachet. Slowly, her fever disappeared. Her strength returned. She began to smile and play again. At her follow-up visits, the transformation was clear. Baina gained weight steadily, eventually reaching 26 pounds. Her health improved significantly. The sick, weak child who arrived at our clinic became a thriving, happy four-year-old. Her mother's gratitude overflowed. "Thank you for giving my daughter her life back," she said. We are deeply grateful to our donors whose generosity made Baina's recovery possible. Rose Mylove arrived at our nutrition center weighing only 12 pounds 10 ounces with severe malnutrition and edema. Her mother stayed with us throughout her treatment. For 39 days, our team provided comprehensive care: therapeutic milk, medications, nutrient-dense foods, and the Medika Mamba program. Rose Mylove responded well to treatment. Her body strengthened. The signs of malnutrition disappeared. On day 39, she was discharged weighing 14 pounds 9 ounces, healthy and ready to go home with her family.

Ten-year-old Liline's mother knew something was wrong. Her daughter had constant stomach pain and no appetite. Living far from our clinic in Rechimaud, she made the difficult journey, hoping for help. Liline weighed only 33 pounds and had level 2 malnutrition. Our team provided treatment and enrolled her in our Medika Mamba program, but recovery required a mother's commitment. Every day, she made sure Liline consumed her dose and encouraged her to eat. After her treatment, Liline had gained nearly 6 pounds. Her pain was gone. Her smile was back. A mother's love made the difference.
