Four-and-a-half-year-old Judlina arrived at our clinic at five months old with severe malnutrition. We educated her mother about nutrition, hygiene, and balanced food groups. Her mother stayed committed. Judlina was enrolled in our outpatient nutrition program. Progress was slow and her weight fluctuated at first, but our team never stopped educating and encouraging her parents. When they returned, the change was clear. Judlina's weight had increased from 27 pounds to 31.5 pounds. This is what parental education can do. When parents understand, children thrive.

Elmise lived with a foster family and struggled greatly in school. She couldn't read or write and couldn't advance to the next grade. We provided after-school tutoring thanks to generous donors. Today, Elmise reads and writes independently. She passed to the next grade with confidence. Thank you for investing in her future.



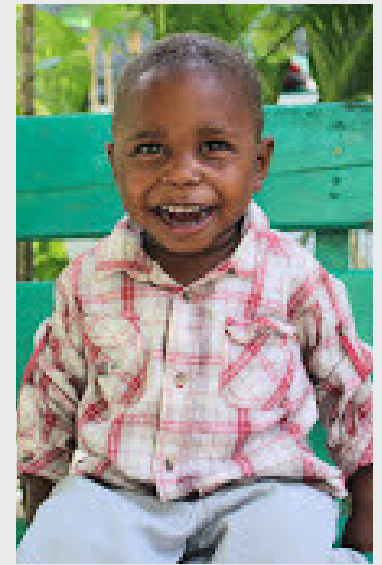
Extra lessons help our Hope Children understand what they're learning in school. Teachers explain things slowly and answer questions children don't understand. This builds knowledge and self-confidence. Lessons also improve school performance. When children practice more and study in a focused way, they get better grades on exams and homework. More importantly, lessons teach discipline, hard work, and responsibility. The Hope Children who take extra lessons develop the tools they need to succeed in school and in life.

I'm a teacher at the nutrition center. When children are hospitalized, they miss school. I help them practice reading, writing, and basic lessons so they can continue learning despite their illness. But education is more than academics. Many children feel sad or scared. Through teaching, I bring hope, courage, and motivation into their lives. Every child deserves the chance to learn, regardless of their circumstances.



VISION: Physically, relationally, and spiritually healthy people contributing to thriving families and strong communities as God designed and desires.

Thirty-three-month-old Flandy arrived at our Nutrition Center in critical condition. Severe acute malnutrition had ravaged his tiny body. Grade 2+ edema made him swell. He weighed only 19 pounds, far too little for a child his age. Our team moved quickly. We created a treatment plan focused on restoring his health, reducing the swelling, and helping his body regain strength. Every day, Flandy received therapeutic feeding, medications, and close monitoring from our medical staff. We never left his side. For seven weeks, we watched him fight.



Slowly, day by day, he improved. His weight climbed to 23 pounds. The swelling disappeared. His strength returned. Today, Flandy is home, healthy and thriving. We are deeply thankful to our donors who make stories like his possible.



My name is Tamara, and I'm a nurse in the Nutrition Center. Every day, I care for children arriving with malnutrition and infections that threaten their lives. We rely on three essential medicines: Ceftriaxone and Azithromycin are antibiotics that fight infections. Paracetamol syrup relieves pain and fever. When a child arrives weak and suffering, we start treatment. After a few days on Ceftriaxone for seven days and Azithromycin for five days, the transformation is remarkable. Children regain strength. Fever breaks. Wounds heal. Paracetamol brings quick relief when children are in pain. These medicines are lifelines. They're only possible because of generous donors who understand that vulnerable children deserve healing. Thank you for saving lives.

My name is Lovemica. I participated in a Bible study based on the book of Galatians, where I learned about patience, faith, and trusting God even when life is difficult. The lesson that stuck with me most is this: when you stay faithful to God's principles, He rewards you in His perfect timing, not always when we want it. I had goals and faced real obstacles, but I kept believing. Today, many of my expectations are becoming reality. This study has changed how I see my life and my future. I'm committed to living biblically and growing in faith. Young people need to know God's Word. It transforms everything.
